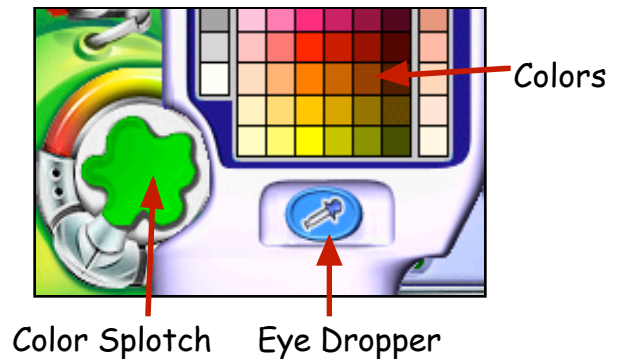


# Getting Started with Kid Pix 4



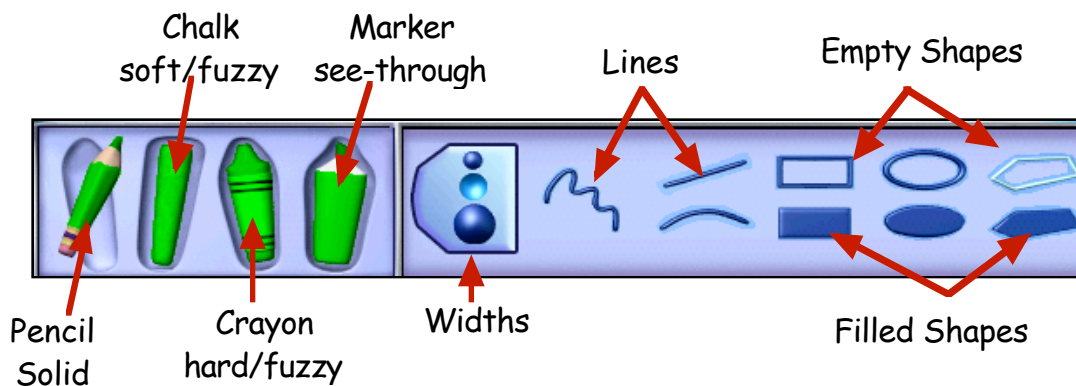
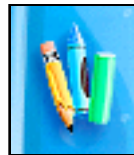
## Pick a color

1. Click on the color splotch to see all the color choices.
2. The eye dropper will let you pick up any color from your picture



## Drawing Tools

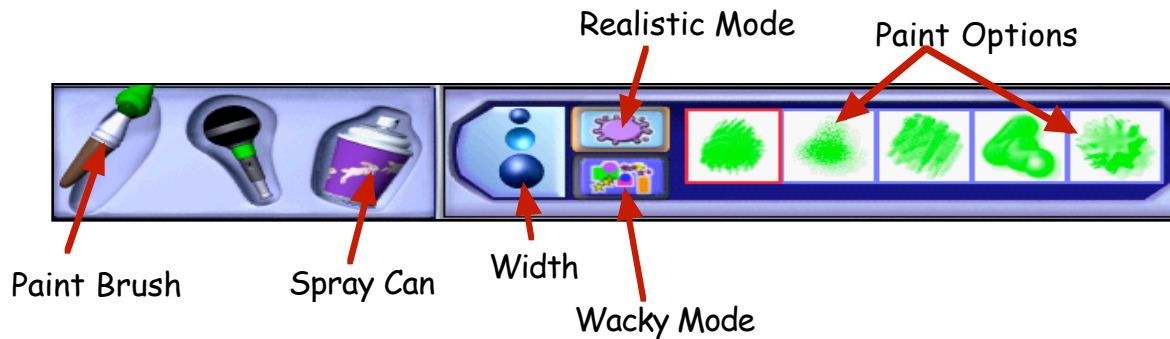
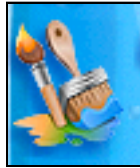
1. Click the Draw button



2. Pick a tool from the felt side of the tray
3. Choose a width size
4. Choose a shape
5. Click in the drawing area and hold down the mouse.
6. Move the mouse around to draw.

# Painting Tools

1. Click the Paint Button

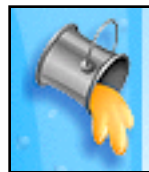


2. Click the Paintbrush or Spray Can tool.
3. Choose a width
4. Choose a painting mode
5. Choose a painting option
6. Click in the drawing area and hold down the mouse button. Move the mouse around to paint.

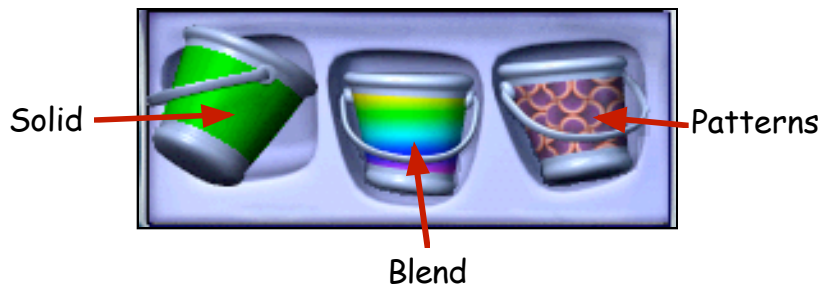
# Paint Bucket

To fill an area

1. Click the Paint Bucket



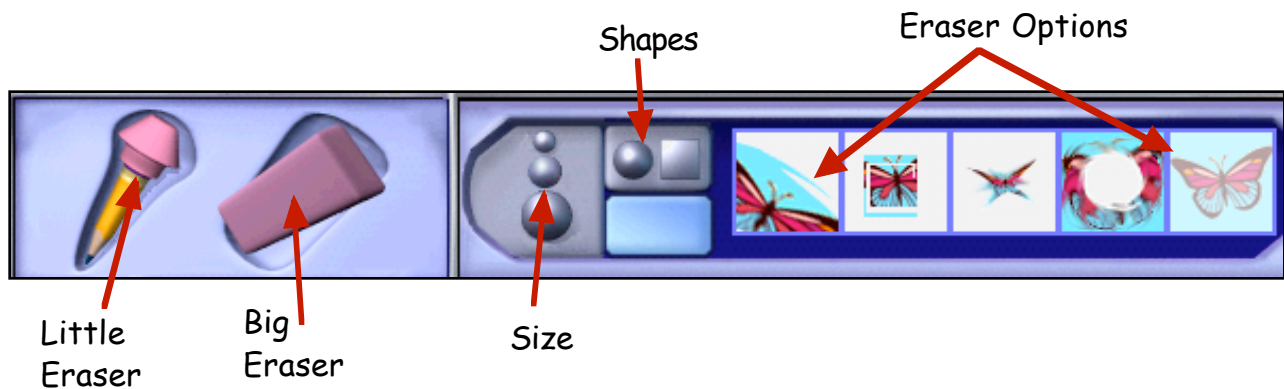
2. Select Solid, Blend, or Pattern fills



3. Place the tip of the drip inside the area you want to fill.

## Erasing

1. Click the Eraser button



### To Erase Part of Your Picture

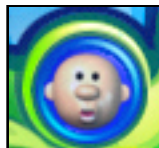
1. Click the Little Eraser
2. Click a size
3. Click a shape
4. Dray where you want to erase

### To Erase All of Your Picture

1. Click the Big Eraser
2. Select an Eraser Option (Never the fire cracker!)
3. Click your picture.

## The Undo Guy

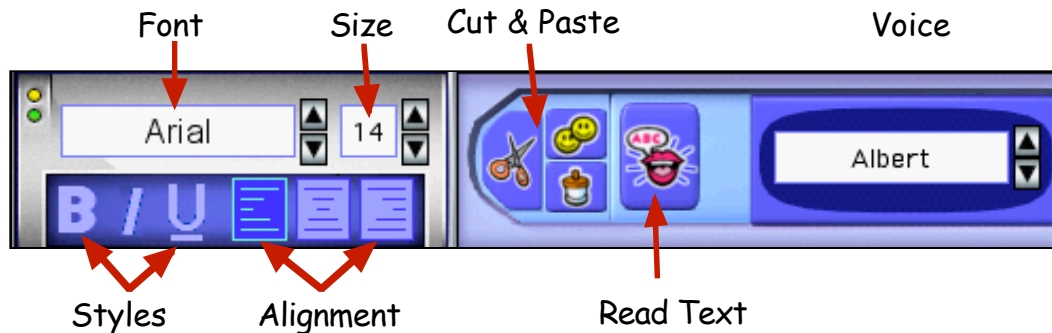
Click the Undo Guy to undo the last thing you did.  
The Undo Guy will only go back one step!



# Text Tools

## To add a Text Box

1. Click the Text Button.



2. Click where you want the text box.

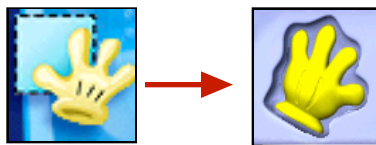
3. Start typing. The text box grows as you type. (It will make a sound if you need to increase the size of the box.)

To paint text onto the background, Click Toolbox > Flatten Text.

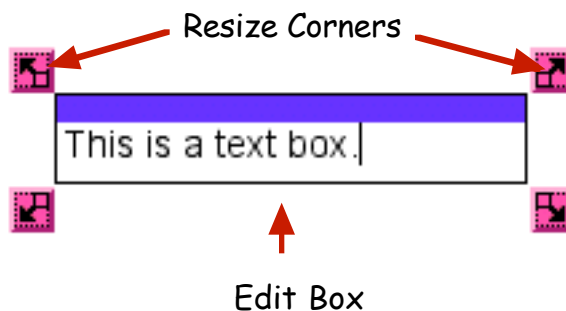
## To Edit a Text Box

1. Click the Grab button.

2. Click the Hand.



3. Click the Text Box to see its edit box
